

Welcome back to the summer term. Year 4 will be learning about many exciting topics this half term and we are very much looking forward to working with you again. We hope you find our newsletter helpful, it will give you some information about what the children will be learning, dates for your diary and some ways to help your child's learning.

English

Stories with issues are the focus of this half terms work, with Jacqueline Wilson's *Cliffhanger and The Suitcase Kid* being the main texts. The children will consider how the writers have conveyed information about their character through the use of inference. They will use this in their own work, writing a story and several haiku based on a range of issues that they have identified. The children will find out about Jacqueline Wilson, including using her website. They will write a blurb, tell a story in postcards and formulate questions. Also they will do further work on grammatical features, spelling work will cover further prefixes and suffixes. Spellings will be tested on a Friday.

Maths

We will be looking at place value, the four number operations $(+ - x \text{ and } \div)$, fractions, geometry, properties of shape (area and perimeter), measurement (volume and capacity, money), decimals and statistics. Regular practise of times tables at home really helps with the children's learning and we appreciate your help with this. Mental arithmetic tests will take place on a Tuesday and cracking time tables will continue to be tested every Friday.

Foundation Subjects

Our topic in science this term will be states of matter (solids, liquids and gases). In geography we are learning about regions in the UK and comparing them to the Chilterns using non-fiction books and computing for research.



In PE we will be developing athletics skills. We are also having swimming lessons every Tuesday.

Our art lessons will be about the study of Roman art. In computing our topic is '*We are authors*' and we will be looking at creating a wiki page about Jacqueline Wilson.



We are going to be continuing to learn about Judaism in RE. In our music lessons we will be continuing our drumming lessons on a Wednesday afternoon.

REMINDERS
