

Year 3 Summer Curriculum Newsletter 2017

Welcome back to the summer term. Year 3 will be learning about many exciting topics this term and we are very much looking forward to working with you again. We hope you find our newsletter useful; it will give you some information about what the children will be learning, dates for your diary and some ways to help with your child's learning.

English

The themes for our English this term are 'Superheroes' and 'Chocolate'. In these we will be using drama to help with characterisation and will be creating adverts and newspaper articles which will involve direct speech. One mythical hero we will be looking at is Heracles and we will be looking at the story of Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.



Maths



We will be looking at fractions, perimeter, place value, the four number operations $(+ - x \text{ and } \div)$, shape, volume and capacity, time, money and statistics. Regular practise of times tables and looking at digital and analogue clocks at home really helps with the children's learning and we appreciate your help with this. Mental arithmetic and time tables will continue to be tested every Monday.

Foundation Subjects

Our topic in science this term will be plants and we will be looking at the parts of plants and planning and carrying out an investigation. In history we are learning about the Ancient Egyptians and using non-fiction books and computing for research.



In our PE lessons we will be playing rounders and taking part in athletic events.

Our art and DT lessons will be linked to our history topic about Ancient Egypt, including painting a pyramid scene and using hieroglyphics.

In our music lessons we will be continuing our recorder lessons on a Tuesday afternoon.

In computing our topics are 'We are communicators' and 'We are opinion pollsters' and we will also be learning how to safely use email. We will also be creating a power point presentation about an aspect of Ancient Egypt.
