Parents' Evenings

We are excited to be able to hold Parents' Evenings in person for the first time in many terms. Following mixed preferences at a recent parent forum meeting, in the future, we are looking to offer both in-person and remote options during the school year.

The arrangements will be slightly different to normal, with Year 3, Year 4 and Blossom appointments taking place in the hall, and, to allow for better spacing, Year 5 and Year 6 appointments taking place in the Year 6 classrooms. Access to appointments will be through the beautiful school courtyard. We ask that parents and carers only come onto the school site immediately before their appointment time, and we will be requesting that all attending appointments wear a face covering.

After your appointment, there will be an opportunity to view some of your children's books.

Events in school

We are currently making plans to return to more of our normal school activities as the year continues. We hope that by the Summer Term we will be able to again have family and child reading sessions in school, visits to classrooms and class assemblies. We are also hoping to be able to offer the return of more of our range of extra-curricular clubs as we move into the Summer Term. We will let you know more about the arrangements and dates for these events closer to the Easter break.



Covid-19 update

As you will be aware, many of the recommendations around Covid-19 and precautions related to this are being reduced by the time we return to school after half-term. We have not yet received updated guidance from the Government and anticipate that this will come during the holidays. We will be maintaining our slightly staggered start and keeping Y3/4 and Y5/6 in distinct groups for breaks and assemblies, as well as maintaining good ventilation and hygiene. We will let you know of any changes after updated guidance has been issued.

Site update

You may have noticed a few changes around the school since January, we have had our new playground gazebo installed at the end of the playground. This is already being used by children as a quiet place to sit during break and lunch, as well as being used for some lessons, since it fits a whole class inside. This week, Year 4 have been singing sea shanties in the gazebo.

We have also been lucky to have updated markings on the playground. The netball courts have been refreshed, as well as the addition of a new game called four square, and a times tables themed hop-scotch marking to help the children remember their 6-9 times tables.
