Keeping your child safe online

Top tips for e-safety

Communicate

Let your child know they should talk to you or an adult they trust if they are worried about something online or something doesn't feel right.

Online friends - do you know them?

People often create fake identities online - make sure your child understands this and is only 'friends' with people they know in the real world.

Location - who could find your child?

Ensure the location and photo geo-tagging is disabled on your child's phone.

Parental controls - have you set these?

Use filters on devices to block inappropriate content and set time restrictions. Never share passwords with other people.

Privacy - who can see your child?

Encourage your child to set their privacy setting to private or 'friends only' on their social networking sites.
