Year 5 will be undertaking a trip to Ufton Court on Tuesday 5th November to find out about Anglo-Saxon daily life and the struggle between the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings to control England. This is a really exciting trip involving some wonderful activities including weaving, fire lighting and battle re-enactments. Please can you complete the consent form along with a voluntary contribution of £20 by Friday 6th October?

To make this trip extra special we would like to use this trip as an opportunity to create footage for a history documentary which your child will be creating in English lessons at the end of the term. We would therefore request that you provide a costume to bring the historical re-enactment to life. If your child is in 5C, please provide a Viking costume and if your child is in 5S, please provide an Anglo-Saxon costume. Please do not spend lots of money on this. There are ideas below on how to create a DIY Viking or Anglo-Saxon costume but please do ask us if you require further help with this. Please note that you do not need to provide weapons as Ufton Court will provide the implements necessary for a safe battle re-enactment!

On the day, we will leave school at 8:30am and return in time for the end of the school day at 3:15pm. Your child will need to wear their school uniform and bring their costume with them to change into when we arrive. They will need a packed lunch and a water bottle for the day. Your child will also need a waterproof coat in case of bad weather!
