School Uniform Guide

We believe a simple and practical uniform helps to create a sense of belonging and pride among our pupils. Below, you will find all the information you need about the school uniform requirements.

Where to buy uniform

PMG Schoolwear are our main uniform supplier and offer items with and without logos. You can:

- visit the PMG Schoolwear shop in central High Wycombe to view and purchase items.
- order online by visiting <https://pmsgschoolwear.co.uk/>, and selecting 'Carrington Junior School' from the schools drop down or click [here](#).
- purchase an iron-on school logo from PMG Schoolwear to apply to non-branded items that need to have a school logo.
- buy unbranded uniform items from any major supermarket or retailer, as long as they meet the uniform requirements below.
- we have a number of second-hand uniform items available to buy at £1 per item. Please contact the school office to browse and purchase.

Uniform requirements

Please ensure items have a school logo on where this is specified below.

Full School Uniform

Weather appropriate uniform can be worn at any time in the year (i.e. no winter / summer requirements). Full school uniform is usually worn three times a week.

- **Bottoms:** Grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress (approximately knee length)
- **Tops:** White polo shirt
- **Jumper:** Royal blue sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan (with school logo)
- **Socks:** White or grey socks (knee or ankle length only)
- **Tights:** Navy or grey tights
- **Footwear:** Black or navy shoes (up to 5cm heel only). Trainers are not permitted.
- **Summer:** sun hat and/or sun screen when appropriate
- **Optional:** Royal blue fleece (with school logo)
- **Optional:** Blue and white striped or checked dress (for warm weather)



Bags

- **Bag for daily use**
- **Forest school kit bag:** Any drawstring named bag in which to store waterproof trousers and jackets in school and to send them home in for washing

P. E. Kit

P.E. kit is worn to school on P.E. days, usually twice a week.

- **Bottoms - winter:** Plain dark jogging bottoms or leggings may be worn in colder weather
- **Bottoms - summer:** Royal blue or black shorts (no hot pants or overtly branded items)
- **Tops:** Royal blue t-shirt (with school logo)
- **Jumper:** Royal blue or navy tracksuit top / hoodie / zip-up (with school logo)
- **Socks:** White or grey socks
- **Footwear:** Trainers for outdoor games



Forest School Kit

Forest school happens on rotation, the schedule will be available once term starts. Children are asked to bring old clothes from home on forest school days (they change into these at school) and must have a waterproof jacket, trousers and wellies.

Important: Arms and legs must be covered in forest school for health and safety reasons (e.g. nettles, brambles or ticks) regardless of weather conditions.

Jewellery, Hair and Nails

- Pupils are not allowed to wear jewellery in school with the exception of recognised pieces for religious observance.
- Pupils with pierced ears may wear small studs which **MUST** be removed for P.E.
- No nail varnish, acrylic nails or make-up is permitted.
- Long hair should be tied back using plain blue, white or red hair bands, slides or ribbons for health and safety reasons.
- No extreme hairstyles e.g. bright colours, spikes or tramlines.
- Digital and analogue watches are permitted but should be removed for P.E.
- Children may wear simple step trackers but these should not be capable of receiving or sending messages or pictures. Expensive items are worn at parents' own risk.

Important reminder: Label all items

May we please request that all items be clearly marked with your child's name. This helps us return lost property efficiently. We are unable to return items of lost property where there is no name.
