Collection at the end of the day

Thank you for adapting to the new start and end times. We are aware that times are tight between some Infant and Junior collection times. We appreciate your efforts to arrive promptly and will completely understand if you are a few moments late for collection.

'Our Time' offer wraparound care for parents that are not able to collect children at the end of school.

Arrival at the start of the day

There are now many more people waiting at the start of the day and the entrance is busy. Please remember that the car park is in use with council taxis dropping off children for the start of the day, and the road is constantly busy. For this reason, we would ask that you please use the large pavement area by the library to wait with your children. The pavement area beside the hedge leading to the Infant School is very narrow and should only be used as a crossing point, not for waiting. This way we can keep the children away from standing on the road leading into the car park and they will be safer.
